## Announcement

**Subject: No Gift Policy for Fiscal Year B.E. 2568**

According to the Cabinet's resolution on December 8, 2020, the national reform plan for the prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct was approved by establishing important reform activities. Goal 1, article 1.1, states that all government agencies to declare themselves as agencies that all government officials do not accept all kinds of gifts and benefits from performing their duties (No Gift Policy). The government agency must execute so that "all government officials shall not accept any kind of gifts or benefits from performing duties".

To promote for creating the drive for good governance in performing work, raising awareness, creating good organizational culture and being a part of guidance in Integrity and Transparency Assessment (ITA), supporting operations under national reform plan for the prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct continuously from the past years, by virtue of Section 27 of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Acts B.E. 2541, it is deemed appropriate to announce the policy of not accepting all kinds of gifts and benefits from performing duties (No Gift Policy) for fiscal year B.E. 2568 and hereby declare the following intentions:

1. King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi (KMUTT) upholds a policy whereby all executives and personnel refrain from accepting any gifts or gratuities related to their official duties, whether before, during, or after their service which will result in corruption and misconduct both in the present and in the future during every festival.
2. Executives and personnel of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi must not seek to obtain gifts, presents, or any other benefits that are unlawful
3. In case of the necessity to give or receive customary gifts and presents, one must consider as appropriate and must perform according to the Regulation of Prime Minister's Office on the Giving or Receiving Gifts by State Officials B.E. 2565, the Announcement of the National Anti-Corruption

Commission on the Criteria for Receiving Property or Other Benefits according to the Ethics of Government Officials, B.E. 2563, and other related laws.

4. The management and superiors at all levels shall supervise the personnel, subordinates and inform all external persons who contact the university of such policy as well as promote and create values of congratulations, expression of good wishes, expressing gratitude, welcoming or expressing condolences as usual tradition by behaving as a role model, recommending or establishing incentive measures to develop the attitude, conscience, and behavior of those under command to consider the economical approach.

Please be informed and comply accordingly.
